





Location

- Hebron is located on the east coast of the US in the Mid-Atlantic region, six miles west of Salisbury, Maryland and part of their Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) and part of the Salisbury Wicomico-Delaware Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO).

Climate

- Hebron, Maryland gets 45 inches of rain, on average, per year. The US average is 38 inches of rain per year.
- Hebron averages 6 inches of snow per year. The US average is 28 inches of snow per year.
- On average, there are 208 sunny days per year in Hebron. The US average is 205 sunny days.

Weather Highlights
